Using single pieces of "film" you will create new images in old "charity-shop" cameras.

Cameras will be provided or bring your own.

We will learn how the cameras work – Lens, aperture, film loading, viewfinder, shutter, exposure; revising and applying the "exposure triangle"

Using pre-cut photographic paper, we will load the cameras in a "changing bag"so that the film negative can be unloaded and developed without the need for a darkroom.

You will have time to experiment making 2 or 3 better/different images.

Learn how to make new photographic prints with the historical & creative process of "Cyanotype". Large format negatives will be provided but you can bring your own. (large being 2"x3" or bigger) Learn what materials react to light and how those changes can be made permanent Coat some paper ready for printing. Expose the sensitised paper to UV light shone through a negative. Develop the print. Tone the print Wash and dry the print

Take away the knowledge and skills to be able to carry out these processes yourself at home (chemistry available online) and hopefully a beautiful image or two!
